**Toshio Nagahama Receives Lifetime Achievement Award from the
Japan Fine Ceramics Association**

On November 10th at the 30th anniversary celebration of the establishment of the Japan Fine Ceramics Association (JFCA), former president and current senior auditor Toshio Nagahama of CoorsTek KK received a Lifetime Achievement Award.

The award was part of a ceremony in which JFCA welcomed its 30th anniversary this year. Awards are given to persons who make special contributions to the promotion of industry through the development of markets and technical innovation, and to the fine ceramics industry through social activities. Mr. Nagahama was one of nine recipients of this year's award. He is credited with having contributed to the development of the market for fine ceramics for semiconductor manufacturing and for putting fine ceramics to practical use.
